

THE WOLF

PENCIL STAND

The idea of the Wolf Pencil Stand came from a need for a 'cool' means of storage for Mr Wolf's collection of mechanical pencils. Just like our work the pencil stand is a handmade prototype and had to be well presented and innovative. The finished product is an example of clever design, form and function and a true representation of our belief in the old school principles of design.

The making of the Pencil Stand began from a set of vintage timber rulers sourced by Mr Wolf. There are two variations of the stand one of which is a small standalone version catering for one or two pencils and the other is a complete stand to cater for a total of eight pencils sitting together. Each of the rulers were cleaned and the varnish coating removed leaving only the bare timber remaining. Two of the rulers were then cut into equal proportions based on the requirements of the design. A selection of pieces were joined together to create the smaller stand and the remaining pieces were used to build the larger version.

Once assembled each item was carefully sanded to ensure every surface and edge was smooth. Once completely smooth, each piece was given a wipe with alcohol and finished with the traditional Wolf walnut stain.

Like many of our Wolf made objects the pencil stand serves the purpose of form and function, it conveniently keeps Mr Wolf's collection of mechanical pencils neatly all in one place whilst looking like a one-of-a-kind piece of art. A perfect desktop statement!
